# The International Climate Initiative (IKI) in a nutshell



Federal budget allocation to IKI

2019: 457 Mio. EUR  
2020: 567 Mio. EUR

# Funding Forest Landscape Restoration in IKI

- Volume of currently implemented projects linked to FLR: EUR M183 (40 projects)
- Thematic focus of currently implemented projects:
  - National and subnational application of Restoration Opportunity Assessment Methodology (ROAM)
  - Implementation of national FLR strategies on the ground: piloting + prepared upscaling
  - Link between FLR and REDD+
  - Mobilizing private finance for FLR and development of business models
  - Deforestation-free supply chains
  - FLR Monitoring & Reporting
  - Global and regional platforms
- Special focus on increasing early stage risk transfer through public-private co-financing for FLR (UNEP-implemented trust fund SCAF-FLR, EUR M25, 2019 – 2027)

# IKI Funding Schemes and Selection Procedures

for climate & biodiversity programmes in developing & emerging countries  
with different thematic and geographical prioritisations

## LARGE-SCALE PROGRAMMES

- Larger funding volume (5 - 20 million EUR)\*
- Longer programme duration (up to max. 8 years)\*
- implemented by a **consortium** (+2 implementing organisations)

## SMALL-SCALE PROJECTS

- Smaller funding volume (up to 800.000 EUR)\*
- Shorter project duration (up to 3 years)\*
- implemented by **individual organisations**

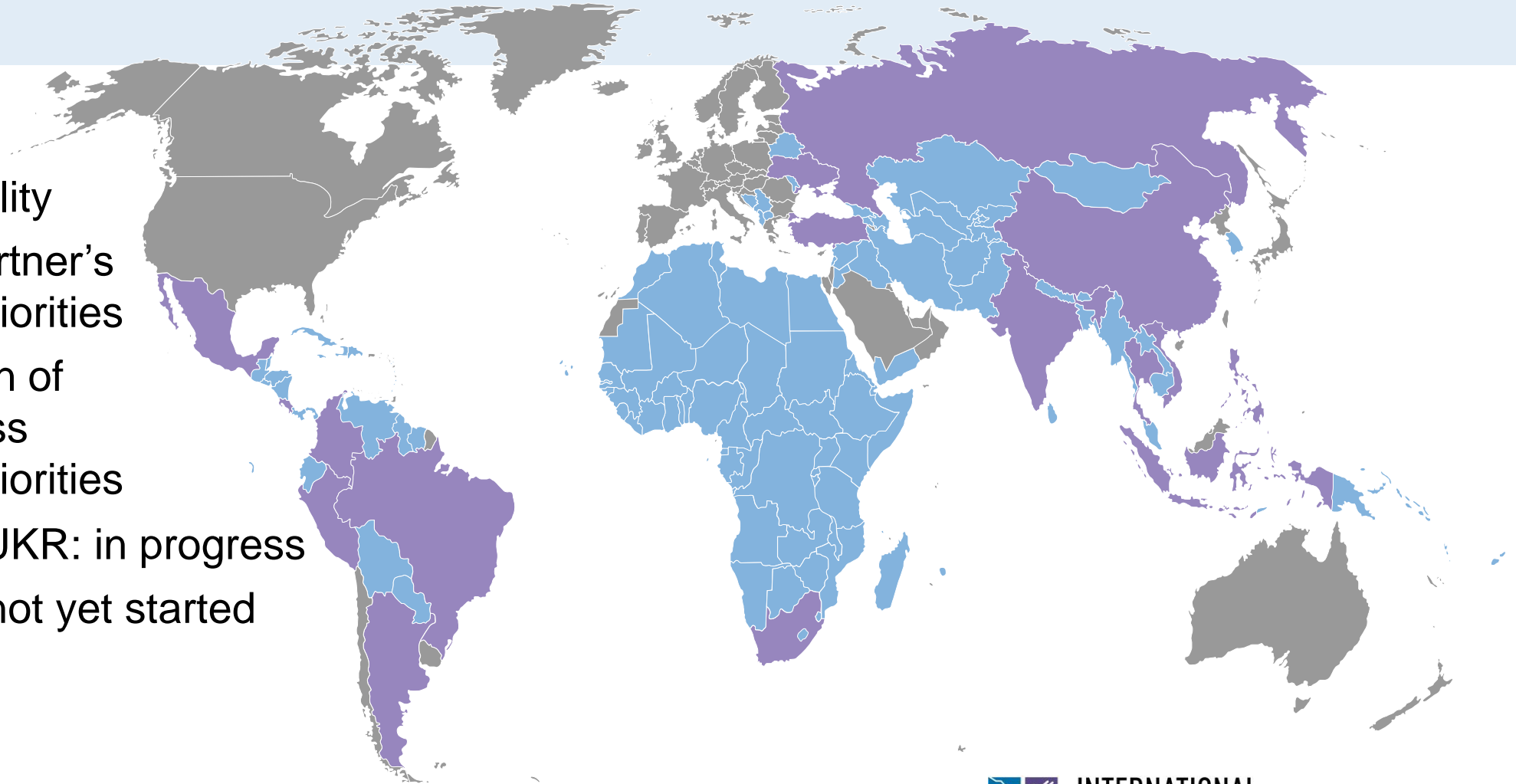

# Selection criteria for programme outlines

- Transformation potential (level of ambition, potential to leverage funds)
- Innovative character
- Synergies with other programmes and activities
- Compliance with IKI Safeguards
- Clear intervention logic and impact monitoring system
- Incorporation of gender mainstreaming and local participation
- Transparency in budget allocation and roles of consortium members
- Sustainability of programme's impacts

# Forest Landscape Restoration in Country Calls

- ODA eligibility
- Political partner's thematic priorities
- Competition of ideas across thematic priorities
- Call 2019 UKR: in progress
- Call TUR: not yet started
